- On the **Details** page of the TV show or movie.
- At the top of the screen for a few seconds when the title starts playing.

REVIEW EVIDENCE — NOT CLEARED

Netflix can tell you a title is leaving. Do not invent the notice.

A real availability notice is evidence only when it actually appears for the title and account state observed.

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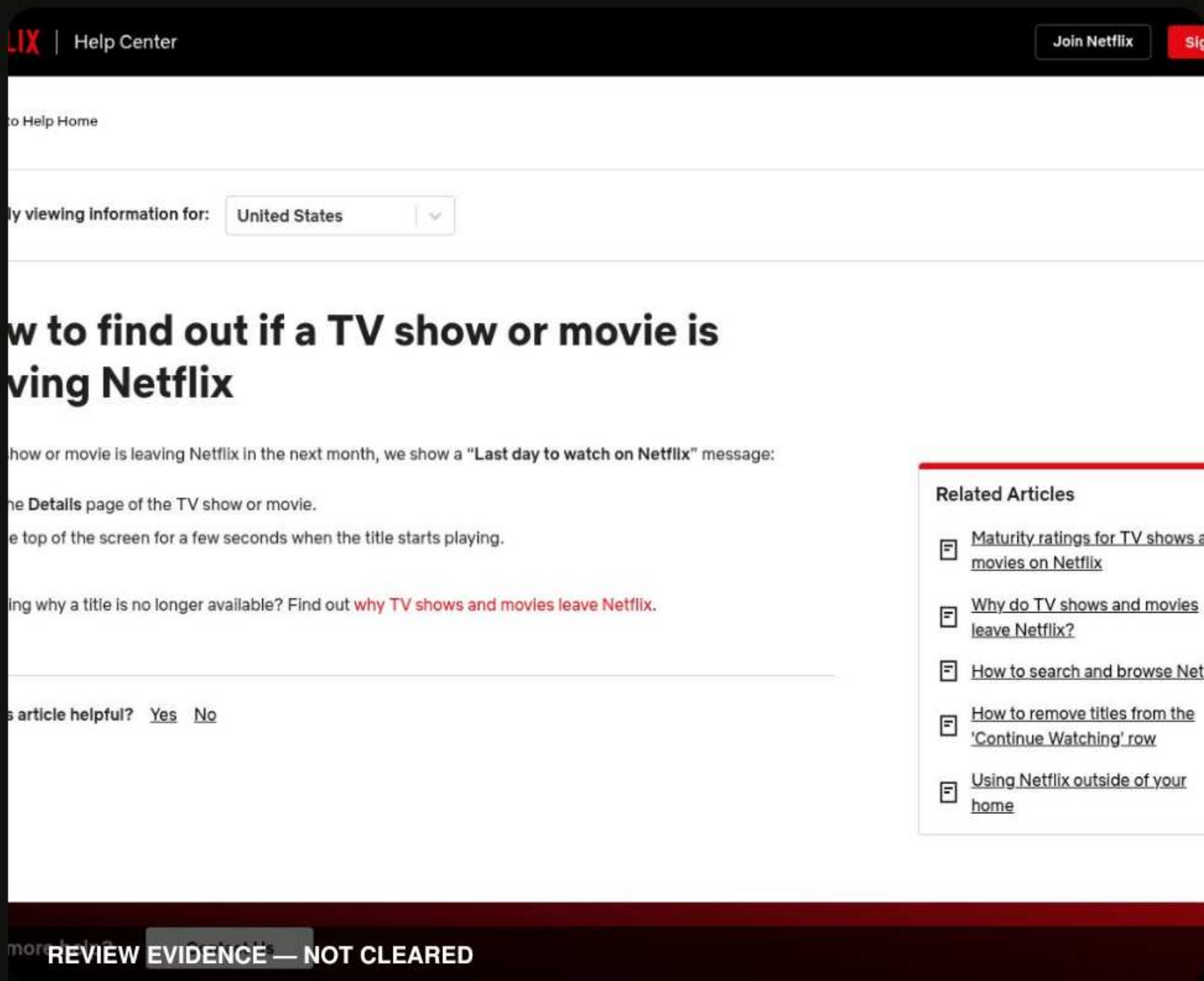
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REVIEW EVIDENCE — NOT CLEARED

Catalog availability can change when a licence window changes.

Availability is contextual, not a permanent property of a title.



A notice must be captured, dated and tied to the exact title surface.

Record title, locale, surface, capture time and visible wording.
