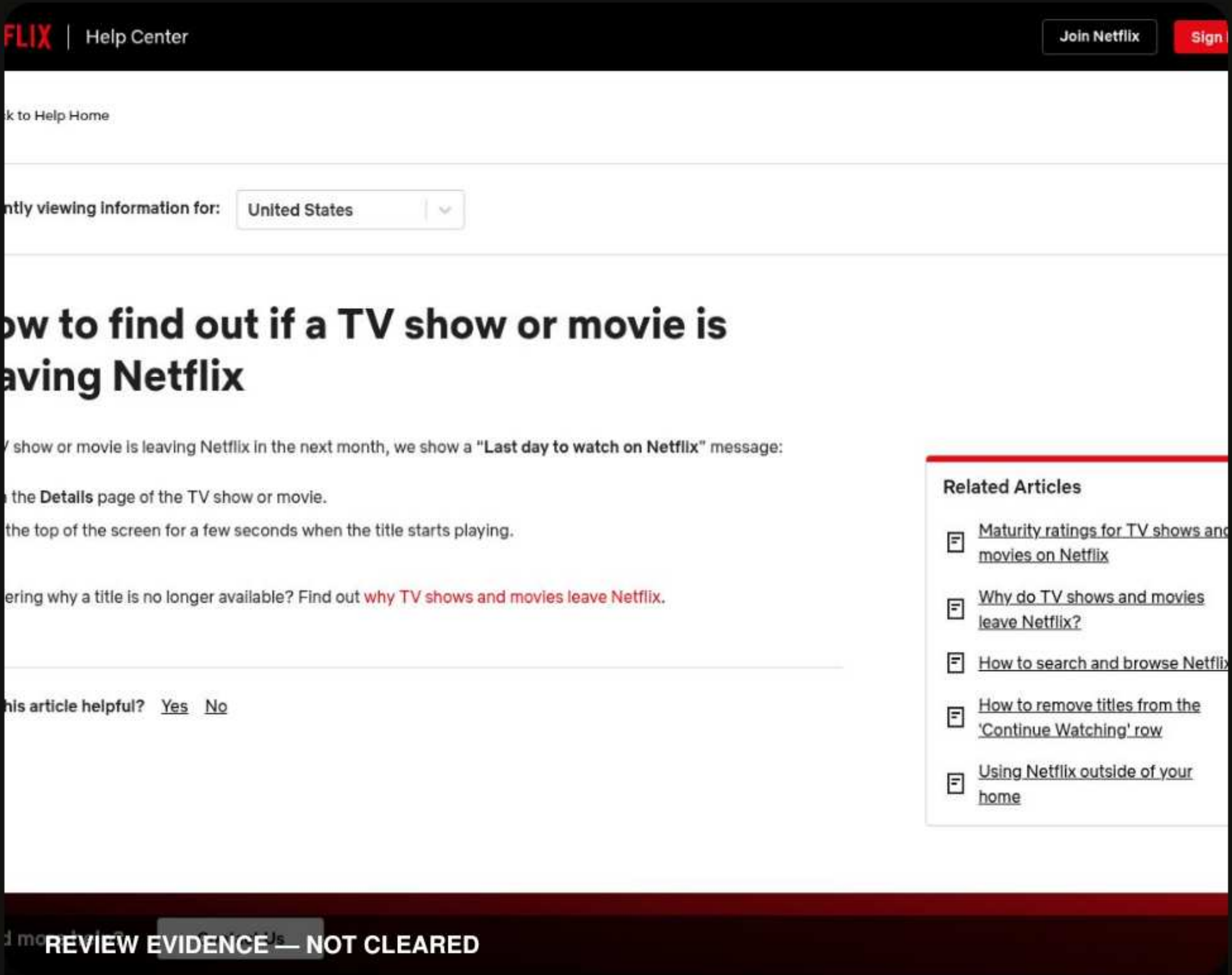

How to find out if a TV show or movie is leaving Netflix

If a TV show or movie is leaving Netflix in the next month, we show a “**Last day to watch on Netflix**” message:

- On the **Details** page of the TV show or movie.
- At the top of the screen for a few seconds when the title starts playing.

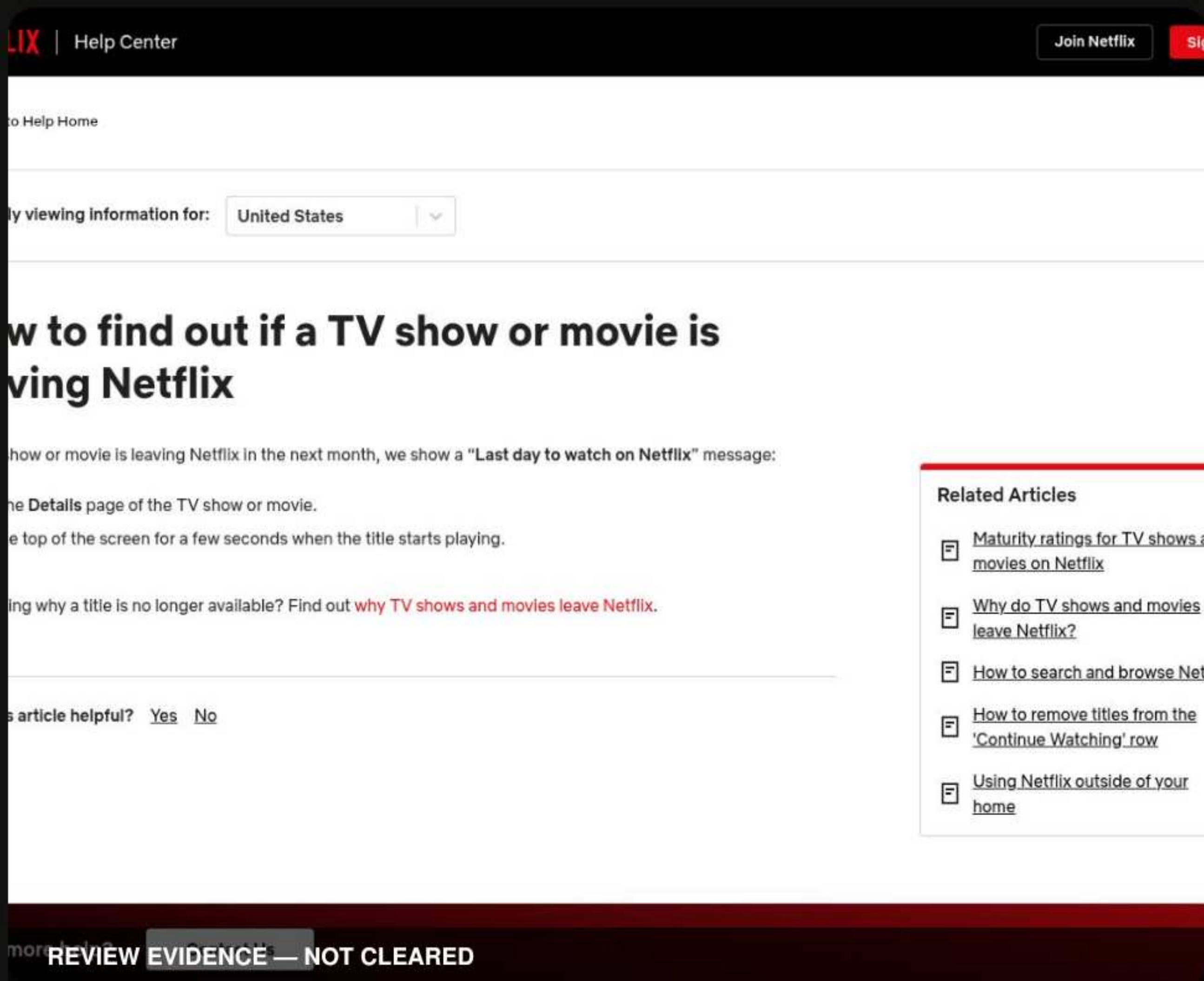
